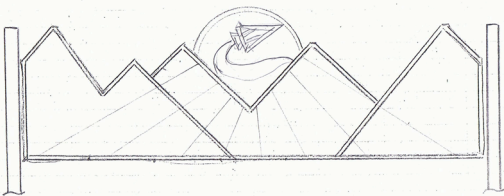
Taking Off
